**MSDS (MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEETS) ARE AVAILABLE, UPON REQUEST, FOR ALL HAZARDOUS MATERIALS WE SELL**

O.S.H.A. has recommended to N.A.I.R. (the National Association of Independent Resurfacers--our trade association) and to the individual finish manufacturers that a respirator be used when mixing or pouring urethane or lacquer finishes (to protect from breathing isocyanates released during agitation of the finish).

N.A.I.R. also suggests that gloves be used when working with water-based finishes, to prevent rashes caused by materials present in the finish.

Further, N.A.I.R. and the finish manufacturers recommend that--for your own protection--you keep pregnant women away from your center while urethane or lacquer finish is being mixed and applied. In this litigious society, this would protect you from any potential lawsuits (should a mother try to prove a link between a deformity in her child and breathing fumes from the finish, for example). We know of no such link--it is strictly a precaution to save you money in defending yourself in a lawsuit.
